Summary of meetings:

June:

- 56 members and one guest attended the May luncheon.
- The ballot for officers was presented. Board of Directors: Carolyn Stocker Knauss, Kathy Marsh Burnett. Pat Smallets Mantz, Joan Sidoti Krablin. Ballot is open until the October meeting when voting will be held. Offices are for a two year term, except for the Corresponding secretary/treasurer.
- A discussion was held on the number of pins/money clips we have at present and a projection of members attending in the next few years. A motion was made and seconded to purchase 15 pins if they are they are still available at the same price purchased in the past.
- Two scholarships were presented: Tabitha Markowski Moore and Gianna Koehler.
- A discussion on the Rules of Order was held. Several changes were suggested; reincorporating two items: members must be either life or dues paying to have voting privileges and hold office and if an officer misses three consecutive meetings, they will automatically forfeit their office. The members were asked to review and bring suggestions to the October meeting. Revisions will be voted upon then.
